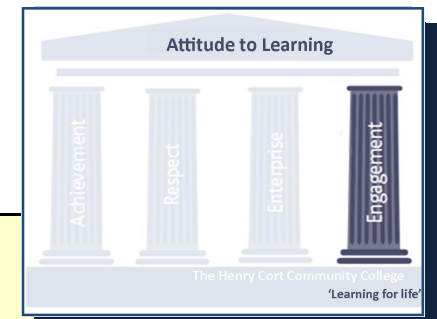




My Attitude to Learning



Outstanding (4)

- I am always well organised (homework, exercise book, equipment).
- I go above and beyond expectations in terms of work and effort.
- I read around the subject and/or do extra work out of interest.
- I work independently, trying to solve problems before asking for help.
- I understand my targets and am keen to meet and exceed them.
- I always work well in a group and support my peers.

Good (3)

- I take a positive approach to learning in the vast majority of lessons.
- I often participate in the lesson by contributing to group and class discussions or activities.

Requires Improvement (2)

- I am usually equipped appropriately.
- I sometimes find working independently challenging and often ask the teacher for help instead of trying to do it myself.
- I sometimes do my homework but it is not always on time or it is occasionally rushed, or not completed to the best of my ability.
- I only take part in group and class discussions/activities if I am asked to.
- I sometimes listen to other peoples' thoughts and ideas but if they aren't the same as mine, I will argue with them.
- I can justify my opinions with simple arguments.
- I am sometimes positive about learning.
- I can sometimes be motivated, when in the right frame of mind.
- I rarely look for ways to improve my level/grade.

Inadequate (1)

- I rarely have correct equipment.
- I show a lack of responsibility for my learning.
- I prefer to answer simple questions and copy information rather than challenge myself.
- I show little interest in self improvement and progression.
- I am unsympathetic to other people's viewpoints.
- I rarely contribute to the lesson, preferring not to take part in group and class discussions.
- I constantly ask my teacher for help rather than trying to solve my own problems.
- I rarely complete my homework.
- I fail to meet deadlines.
