### Outstanding (4)

- · Meets all deadlines and is well organised
- Produces quality assessments to the best of their ability and of the highest standards
- Works independently outsides of lesson to extend their learning
- Prepares independently and very thoroughly for all tests/assessments

## Good (3)

- · Meets deadlines and is well organised
- · Produces home learning to the best of their ability
- Can work well independently outside of lessons to support their learning
- Prepares willingly and effectively for tests/assessments

### Working towards (2)

- · Sometimes misses home learning deadlines
- Does not always produce home learning to the best of their ability, and may be incomplete
- Sometimes works outside of the lesson to improve their learning
- Sometimes prepares wells for tests/assessments, although this preparation may lack depth

# Inadequate (1)

- Frequently misses deadlines
- Does not always produce home learning of their ability and/or quality, and is often incomplete
- Completes little work outside of lessons
- Rarely undertakes adequate preparation for tests/assessments

# Outstanding (4)

- Always well-organised, punctual, and fully equipped

- Works independently and aims for continual improvement
- Takes pride in work; well-presented and creative
- Responds fully to teacher feedback
- Thinks deeply and expresses own viewpoints clearly

# Good (3)

- Usually punctual and well equipped
- Shows motivation and engages in most of the lesson
- Participates in most lessons and occasionally works with others
- Works independently, occasionally needs support and aims to do
- Work is organised and presentable
- Responds to feedback when prompted
- Considers responses and sometimes expresses viewpoints

#### Working towards (2)

- Occasionally late or missing equipment
- Limited motivation and struggles to engage in lesson
- Limited participation in lesson and struggles to work with others
- Struggles with independent work, seeking help first and aims to do the minimum
- Work lacks organisation and is not well presented
- Rarely responds to feedback unless pushed
- Struggles to respond and rarely expresses viewpoints

#### Inadequate (1)

- Frequently late and frequently has no equipment
- Lacks motivation and does not engage in lesson
- Avoids participation and is unable to work with others
- Unable to work independently and avoids work
- Work is disorganised and messy
- Will not respond to feedback
- Unable to respond or express viewpoints
