Overview of role

As Pupil Premium Progress Lead you will play a pivotal role in ensuring the progress of students who qualify for pupil premium across the college curriculum. This position requires a passionate teacher who can analyse data, liaise with staff and monitor targeted interventions to narrow the achievement gap and enhance the overall educational experience for disadvantaged students.

Key Responsibilities

- Collaborate with the Vice Principal and Transition Manager to align pupil premium priorities with the college improvement plan.
- Keep accurate records of pupil premium students' progress.
- Generate reports for SLT and governors as required.
- Analyse progress data across the year to identify trends and patterns related to pupil premium students' academic performance, attendance and behaviour.
- To use pen portrait data to identify support areas for individual and/or groups of pupil premium students.
- Respond to trends in data by identifying measurable action points and reviewing progress made.
- Work as part of the Teaching and Learning Team to ensure the needs of pupil premium students are at the heart of driving classroom practice.
- Meet with Heads of Faculty to identify specific learning needs of Pupil Premium in their faculty, including the impact of poor attendance and action points needed to address. Offering support and reviewing progress.
- Provide updates, training and resources for staff to enhance their ability to support pupil premium students to make progress.
- Run support sessions for students and parents as appropriate.
- Stay informed about the latest research and best practices related to closing the achievement gap.

The successful candidate will have:

- A strong understanding of the challenges faced by disadvantaged students.
- Good data analysis skills and the ability to use data to inform decision-making.
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills with staff and parents.
- The ability to lead and inspire colleagues towards a shared vision of closing the attainment gap.
- An understanding of the best practices related to pupil premium.
