Impact on the students

Pupil progress data shows that those students who demonstrate growth mind-set characteristics radically outperform other students by as much as 4 grades, even though their KS2/CAT tests show they have similar raw intelligence.

Visit www.scopay.com/thehenrycort and Register as a New User. Follow the instructions on the screen to enter your details and add the unique online link code for Ben when prompted.

Note: Online link code is for one time use only. It is not needed once the account has been




