## **Summer School Arrangements (26 – 30 July 2021)**

In order for everyone to enjoy themselves and benefit from the summer school, our behaviour expectations are the same as they always are. Therefore, please note the following:

- Mobile phones are not to be used at school. If you wish your child to bring a phone for the journey to and from college then they must be switched off and in their bags as soon as they come through the gate. If you wish to contact them during the day, you may do so via the college office on 01329 843127. We will confiscate any phones that are misused and you will need to collect them at the end of the day.
- We will not tolerate poor behaviour towards other students or a member of staff.
- Students should be suitably dressed – comfortable, casual clothes but no strappy or cropped tops, miniskirts or skimpy shorts. Students will require PE kits for Monday and Wednesday and will be doing activities all day Friday. Please also bear in mind the weather, especially for our Friday outing and ensure that students dress accordingly and have sunscreen with them if necessary. It may be an idea to pack a spare set of clothes on the Friday just in case!
- We expect students to have their own equipment with them just as we expect them to in September. There is an option to pre-order a ready to learn pack, please refer to the transition day letter for details.

If your child is repeatedly unable to meet our expectations, we will call you to collect them. Unfortunately, we will not take any students on our outing if we do not feel we can rely on them to meet our expectations.

Excluding events outside of your control, I do ask that you only commit to the days that you know your child can definitely attend so that we can ensure we have the correct student-staff ratios and we can budget for catering, resources, book tickets for Fairthorne Manor.
