As you are aware, exams have begun this week and we would like to take this opportunity to wish you and your child every success over this exam period. Overall, we have been impressed with how incredibly hard your children have been working and are looking forward to congratulating them when their results are released in August. As always, we will endeavour to help as much as possible.

As you may be aware, we finalised the exam warm-up schedule for students last week. This was given to our Year 11s and includes a calendar detailing when your child is expected in college after half term. As detailed in our recent 'exam ready' information evening, Henry Cort does not allow Year 11 to have whole college study leave. Instead, we expect students to remain in college and attend all lessons for those subjects where they still have exams to sit.

Once students have finished any given subject, those lessons become 'independent study periods', where they are free to either revise at home, or ideally attend college and use our library. We have found with experience that the latter is far more conducive to active learning for the majority of our students.

A copy of individual exam timetables has been emailed to all students' henrycort.co.uk accounts. Students were reminded that they must always attend in full uniform and sign in and out of the college site at reception, unless they arrive and depart with all other students at the start and end of the normal college day. Students were also reminded to remain available up until the contingency exam day on **Wednesday 29 June 2022**. If in the event the college is instructed by the exam boards to reschedule an exam, it will take place on this day.

I can also now confirm students' last day at Henry Cort will be **Monday 4 July 2022**, when we will host a leavers assembly at 12:30pm. Whilst students are expected to attend in full uniform, they have been encouraged to bring a spare shirt if they wish to participate in the 'shirt signing' tradition. Students will also be able to pick up their prom tickets from this point
