## **Romeo and Juliet Theatre Trip**

Your child is attending the trip to see Romeo and Juliet at the RSC Theatre, Stratford-Upon-Avon on **Monday 25 March**.

Please find below, the final arrangements for the trip. Please note that the timings differ slightly to our previous letter.

9:30— Students to meet in the canteen and register with a member of staff (eligible students can collect their free packed lunch to take with them. Please ensure you let us know if your child requires this)

10:10 - Coach leaves college

12:30-13:00 – Arrival in Stratford-Upon-Avon (this time is approximate)

14:00 – 15:30 – Performance – The performance is 1 hour 30 minutes long and there is no interval

16.00 - Depart Stratford-Upon-Avon

18:30-19:00 - Expected arrival back at college (traffic dependent)

Please remind your child that they are representing both themselves and the college and it is an expectation that students' behaviour is excellent at all times. Students MUST be in full college uniform. There will be lots of other schools and members of the public in attendance we need to be able to identify our students at all times. Any students who do not arrive in full uniform, will not be able to attend the trip.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and any snacks required for the trip. We will be asking students NOT to eat these during the performance as we do not want anyone's enjoyment of the performance to be spoiled by any noise.

The theatre has informed us that they will be carrying out bag checks in the interests of security. Students need to be aware of this and that there is also a restriction on bag size. Large rucksacks can be left in the theatre cloakroom free of charge however we recommend students do not bring large bags so they can keep all belongings on their person.

Additionally, whilst the RSC is an indoor theatre, we are likely to spend some time outside of the theatre if we arrive early to allow students to have something to eat and to stretch their legs after a long coach journey. Please ensure that students have appropriate coats/jackets so they can keep warm on the day.
