Year 11 GCSE Easter Support Sessions

As we approach the exam season, I wanted to give you notice of the Easter GCSE support sessions which we are offering as part of our on-going support for our students for some subject areas to run alongside the afterschool revision sessions. Staff have volunteered to lead sessions in the first week of the Easter holidays between **Monday 30th March – Thursday 2nd April**. Below is the timetable for the subjects offering sessions, these sessions will provide additional support to enhance understanding and confidence in various subjects.

These sessions are entirely voluntary, but I highly encourage students to take advantage of this opportunity to consolidate their learning and address any specific concerns they may have before their exams.
